NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be received by the Business Administrator for the Township of Rockaway, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, on **THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 6, 2018 at 11:00 am** prevailing time in the Administration Office at the Municipal Building at 65 Mount Hope Road, Rockaway, New Jersey 07866 at which time and place bids will be opened and read in public for:

ROOF REPLACEMENT AT THE ROCKAWAY TOWNSHIP SENIOR CENTER

At the above time and place, all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. No bids will be accepted after the date and time designated to receive bids. A bid may be withdrawn prior to the time for opening of bids or authorized postponement thereof upon written application of the Bidder who shall be required to produce evidence showing that individual is or represents the principal or principals involved in the bid. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after bids have been opened.




Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope, clearly marked with the project identification and the name and address of the Bidder. Bids may be submitted by certified mail, return receipt requested, regular mail or hand delivery. Bids shall be submitted to the Office of the Township Business Administrator, Municipal Building, 65 Mount Hope Road, Rockaway, New Jersey 07866. The Bidder shall submit only one (1) bid that meets or exceeds the minimum specifications herewith.

Funding for this project is provided by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development to the County of Morris. Therefore, the Federal Labor Standards Provisions and Davis Bacon wage rates and reporting will apply. Attention is called to the fact that the contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, sex, affectional or sexual orientation and to the greatest extent possible, opportunities for training and employment shall be given to lower-income residents of the project areas and that, when possible, contracts shall be awarded to business concerns owned by area residents. Small, minority and Women's Business Enterprises, and Section 3 business (contracts over \$100,000) are encouraged to submit bids.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of Executive Order 11246 – Discrimination and the Copeland Anti-Kickback Act.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27-1 et seq.
