Bids may be submitted by certified mail, return receipt requested, regular mail or hand delivery. Bids shall be submitted to the Office of the Township Business Administrator, Municipal Building, 65 Mount Hope Road, Rockaway, New Jersey 07866. The Bidder shall submit only one (1) bid that meets or exceeds the minimum specifications herewith.
