

ROCKAWAY TOWNSHIP SHADE TREE COMMISSION

APRIL 8, 2019

THE MEETING STARTED AT 8:11PM AT THE ROCKAWAY TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL BUILDING. THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS WERE THERE: MARK HILER, TOM PERRAULT, EDITH YATES AND LINDA HILER. THE MINUTES FROM OUR LAST MEETING WERE ACCEPTED AS READ. THE SHADE TREE COMMISSION'S BANK ACCOUNT CONTAINS \$983.30 AT PRESENT.

WE ARE PLANNING TO HAVE AN ARBOR DAY CELEBRATION THIS YEAR. WE WILL PLANT A READ OAK, THE NEW JERSEY STATE TREE, IN MEMORY OF MAYOR DACHISEN. OUR TOWNSHIP DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS HAS AGREED TO PLANT THE TREE FOR US. WE WILL ORDER A BRONZE PLAQUE TO HONOR THE MAYOR FOR HIS SERVICE TO OUR TOWNSHIP.

THE ROUND HILL APARTMENT COMPLEX DEVELOPMENT SITE WAS DISCUSSED. WE WILL CHECK TO SEE IF THE REQUIRED SNOW FENCE ABUTTING THE EXISTING HOMES WAS DAMAGED.

IT WAS REPORTED TO THE COMMISSION THAT A DEAD ASH TREE IS LEANING OVER LEE WAY IN THE TOWNSHIP. TOM PERRAULT WILL LOOK INTO THIS.

WE DISCUSSED THE FED EX, INC. LANDSCAPE PLAN FOR THEIR PROPERTY ON GREEN POND ROAD. THIS PLAN INCLUDES RED OAKS AND AN EVERGREEN MIX. THE TOWNSHIP ENGINEER WILL MEET WITH THEIR LANDSCAPER AT THE SITE.
